Course Name: Wetland Science and Practice

Credit Hours and Contact Hours: 3 credit hours and 3 contact hours

Catalog Description including pre- and co-requisites: A survey and in-depth investigation of wetland terms and types, characteristic features and processes, and delineation, management and restoration practices. The course examines wetland hydrology and biogeochemical processes

Read articles in peer-viewed wetland journals and demonstrate knowledge of current issues in wetland science and applied practices (i.e., wetland delineation, management, and restoration) via written and orally presented literature reviews (*reading, oral communication, citizenship, professional competency*).
